Dear Overleigh Family,

We hope that you have had an enjoyable break and we look forward to welcoming you back to school tomorrow to start the new term in your new year groups.

Our staff have been busy preparing their classrooms and planning out the children's work and experiences for the new academic year. This includes some excellent work by Mr Flynn and Mr Littlewood to enhance the school grounds and Forest School provision. We ask you, as ever, to please give your child a chance to settle in with their new teacher/s in the first few weeks. If there are any big issues then just let the class teacher know but otherwise please allow them time to settle in to their new surroundings.

As mentioned in the newsletter before the break, there will be no snack for sale at break times. Children in EYFS and Key Stage 1 will continue to be provided with a healthy fruit snack by school. Children in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be allowed to bring an item of fruit with them as a break snack. Any snacks other than fruit will be sent home with the child at the end of the day. Could everyone check that their child (ren) is not stashing snack food, such as sweets and chocolate, in their school bags before school, as this occurred on a couple of occasions last year.

We would appreciate your support with a big push on school uniform. It is important that all children follow the uniform policy, including that children wear black shoes and definitely not trainers (including black trainers which look like shoes). Likewise, it is imperative that children bring their PE kit to school preferably in a drawstring bag. PE kit should remain in school each day so that children have access at all times. If children are not in the correct uniform, including PE kit, then school will find them appropriate clothing on the day to replace items that are not part of the uniform policy. PE kit is a white t-shirt and black shorts with pumps for inside, and appropriate outdoor sports shoes. Children can bring appropriate joggers and fleeces for outdoor PE in the colder weather but should still be wearing the white t-shirt beneath these. All clothing needs to have your child's name on the inside somewhere, including footwear and coats.

Children should only be wearing stud earrings for school and must be able to remove these themselves for PE activities. Year 6 will continue with swimming as one of their PE lessons in the Autumn Term. The resumption date for swimming will be given to them in the first week back. Forest School days will be shared with children in the first week back and will commence in the week beginning Monday 9th September.

Pencil cases and such equipment are not required, therefore please do not send stationery equipment in. The class teachers have adequate equipment that all the children can use.

Lastly, a reminder that school opens its doors at 8.40 am and that any child arriving after 8.50 am will be deemed to be late and a reason needs to be given at the main office by the adult accompanying them to school. Any children arriving after 9.00 am will be deemed as a half-day absence. Please bring medical notes/appointment details if you child has been to an appointment.

Thank you for your support with the above. Apologies for having to list the information again but it helps considerably with the smooth running of the school and with your child's engagement with learning if the above expectations can be followed. There are a few important messages later in the newsletter, including some really important information about our school contact email. It is only a brief newsletter to welcome you back to school. Hopefully, any new children and their families that join us today can be given the friendly and warm welcome that we would expect from the Overleigh community and can be helped to integrate happily and confidently into our school. We look forward as ever to sharing information about your child's work throughout the academic year through our regular newsletters and to adding more dates and exciting opportunities/events into the calendar as the year progresses. Please see the current key dates on the following pages. Each year group will be updating their year group page on the website and also sharing the information about the new year group expectations and learning through the meet the teacher presentations in a few weeks time. Our staff cannot wait to greet your children back into school on Tuesday 3rd September to begin what is hopefully a happy, healthy and successful year for everyone in our school. Important Message Regarding School Email


Due to an absence in the IT department (Local Authority) during the Summer holiday, the school email address has not yet been changed. We are expecting this to happen in time for next week.

Dear Parent/Carer,

Our school is part of Operation Encompass which is a national scheme that operates jointly between schools and police forces.

Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced domestic abuse.

As a school we have ensured that a members of our staff, Emma Drew (Headteacher) & Sheila Edwards (Designated Safeguarding Lead) known as a Key Adult, has been trained in the Operation Encompass procedures allowing us to then use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to support the child/ren in our care.


The Domestic Abuse Act 2021 identifies children who experience domestic abuse as victims of domestic abuse in their own right.
